Beginning Tuesday, April 29, the monthly CSEPP siren tests will use a tone that sounds like Westminster chimes – what some people say sounds like a door bell or the chimes of a grandfather clock.

Now it will be easier to tell the difference between the sirens’ test and emergency tones. If the Umatilla Chemical Depot has an emergency, sirens will make a solid, steady warning tone for three minutes straight, meaning you should take protective action.

Be prepared if you live or work in the emergency zones close to the Umatilla Chemical Depot in Oregon or in Washington. Know the CSEPP siren tones and what to do.
