CSEPP siren test scheduled for, Tuesday, August 29

Pendleton, Ore. – The monthly test of the Oregon Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness Program (CSEPP) siren system is scheduled for noon on Tuesday, August 29. The test coincides with tests of CSEPP sirens on the Umatilla Chemical Depot and in Benton County, Washington. All 76 CSEPP sirens will use the Westminster chimes during the test.

The sirens are one of five public warning systems located in communities that surround the Umatilla Chemical Depot. They are tested on a routine basis but would only be used in the event of a Umatilla Chemical Depot emergency.
