### Depot plans drills next week

**Umatilla Chemical Depot, Hermiston, Ore.** – The depot plans two drills for emergency preparedness and security readiness Tuesday and Wednesday, Sept. 5 and 6.

The depot's Westminster chimes will be sounded on both days, but not the community sirens. These are coordinated exercises between the depot, the Umatilla Chemical Agent Disposal Facility, and off-post communities.

Although these are only drills, such events are excellent opportunities for individuals – whether at home or work – to stop and ask themselves if they, their families, loved ones or co-workers know what to do if an actual emergency or security incident were to occur. Chemical Stockpile Emergency Preparedness officials recommend residents develop emergency plans for their homes and businesses, and in these times of heightened security, be vigilant about their surroundings.
