

Boaters

In a chemical emergency, boaters on the Columbia River will be directed to evacuate the river.

If safe, boaters should return to their landing point and follow the emergency instructions issued for that area.

CALL TAKER

- *Ask where their landing point is.*
- Review current plume direction.
 - If landing site **is not** in plume path
 - Have them return to landing site.
 - Advise them what to do next. I.e. evacuate or shelter in place.
 - If landing site **is** in plume path
 - Boater should not return to that site.
 - Boater should travel away from the Depot.

Evacuating

When they arrive at their landing point, they should

- Evacuate using the recommended route.
- While driving tune radio to hear additional emergency instructions
 - In Oregon, tune to FM 92.1 (KUMA)
 - In Washington, tune to FM 105.3 (KONA) or AM 610 (KONA)

Sheltering in Place

When they arrive at their landing point, tell them to take shelter in their car.

They should:

- Close all windows and doors
- Shut vents
- Turn on their radio.
 - In Oregon, tune to FM 92.1 (KUMA)
 - In Washington, tune to FM 105.3 (KONA) or AM 610 (KONA)
- Turn off their engine
- Wait until the radio tells them they can leave the area.
