

# Emergency Zones

## Immediate Response Zone (IRZ)

This area closest to the Umatilla Chemical Depot extends to approximately eight miles from the Depot. It includes the Cities of Irrigon in Morrow County; Echo, Hermiston, Stanfield, and Umatilla in Umatilla County; Plymouth and Paterson in Benton County, Washington.

The IRZ has been divided into 12 smaller areas called **sectors**. Ten sectors are located in Oregon, two are in Washington.

People can look at the silver label on the side of the Tone Alert Radio to determine what sector they are in. A list and description of IRZ sectors follows.

## Protective Action Zone (PAZ)

This emergency-planning zone surrounds the IRZ and covers an area up to approximately 20 miles from the depot. It includes the City of Boardman in Morrow County.

The PAZ has been divided into nine smaller areas called sectors. Six sectors are located in Oregon and three in Washington.

People can look at the silver label on the side of the Tone Alert Radio to determine what sector they are in. A list and description of PAZ sectors follows.

## Marine Safety Zone (MSZ)

A stretch of the Columbia River approximately 20 miles above and 20 miles below McNary Dam. The boundaries are Juniper Canyon on the east (upstream side) to Crow Butte State Park on the west (downstream side).

# Emergency Zones (IRZ Sectors)

## Immediate Response Zone (IRZ) Sectors

This is the area closest to the Umatilla Chemical Depot. It starts at the Depot fence and extends approximately eight miles in all directions. It includes the cities of Irrigon, Echo, Hermiston, Stanfield, and Umatilla in Oregon; Plymouth and Paterson in Benton County, Washington.

The IRZ has been divided into 12 smaller areas called **Sectors**. Ten of the Sectors are in Oregon and two are in Washington.

People can look at the silver label on the side of the Tone Alert Radio to determine what Sector they are in.

## OREGON SECTORS

### *Umatilla County*

- **Sector A-1** – is the area between the Morrow County Line and the Umatilla River including the **South Hill area of the city of Umatilla**. The northern border is the Columbia River while the Depot is the southern border.
- **Sector A-2** – is the area east of the Depot including NE I-84 out to the eastern line of Three Mile Dam. The east border is the Umatilla River and the southern border is the intersection of Westland & Agnew roads.
- **Sector B** –the **City of Umatilla** and an area that runs from the Umatilla River east to Ott Road, Craig Road, and Box Canyon. The northern boundary is the Columbia River. The southern boundary is Punkin Center Road.
- **Section C** –the **City of Hermiston** and an area that runs from the Umatilla River east to Ott Road. The northern boundary is Punkin Center Road. The southern boundary is
  - Feedville Road.
- **Sector D** – includes the **Cities of Stanfield and Echo** and an area east of the Umatilla River. This sector also includes the Hinkle, Echo Meadows, and Stanfield Meadows areas. The northern boundary is Feedville Road.

- **Section E** –an area from the Army depot and the Morrow County line east to the Umatilla River and Butter Creek. The northern boundary runs from the Agnew Road – Westland Road intersection to the depot. The southern boundary is the High Line Canal.

*Morrow County*

- **Sector F** –in Morrow County, southwest of the depot. This sector runs from Bombing Range Road east to the Umatilla County line. Northern boundary is Interstate 84. The southern boundary is Homestead Road.
- **Sector G -1** – is the area from West Fourth Street **including the City of Irrigon** and east to the Umatilla County Line. The northern border is the Columbia River. The southern border is the Depot.
- **Sector G - 2** – is the area from Paterson Ferry Road to the Columbia River then West Fourth Street and the west boundary of the Depot and finally I-84.
- **Sector H** –an area that runs from the east side of Boardman east to Paterson Ferry Road. The northern border is the Columbia River. The southern border is Interstate 84.

WASHINGTON SECTORS

*Benton County*

- **Sector J** is the area between Highway 14 on the north and the Columbia River on the south, and Paterson on the west and Christy Road on the east.
- **Sector K** is the area between Highway 14 on the north and the Columbia River on the south, and Christy Road on the west to Plymouth on the east.

# Emergency Zones (PAZ Sectors)

## Protective Action Zone (PAZ) Sectors

This emergency-planning zone surrounds the IRZ and covers an area up to approximately 20 miles from the depot. It includes the City of Boardman in Morrow County. The Protective Action Zone is further away from the Depot, so people there will have a little more time to take action, if necessary.

## OREGON SECTORS

### *Umatilla County*

- **Sector N** –the area east of Umatilla and Hermiston. This sector runs from Ott Road east to Cold Springs Road (Highway 37). The northern boundary is the Columbia River. The southern boundary is Feedville/Despain Gulch Road.
- **Sector P** –an area in Umatilla County that runs from Highway 395 (not including Stanfield and Echo) east to McClintock, Lorenzen, and Rew Roads. The northern boundary is Feedville/Despain Gulch Road. The southern boundary is the Umatilla River.
- **Sector Q** – an area that runs from the Morrow County line east to Mud Springs Canyon Road. The northern boundary is the High Line Canal, Hunt Ditch, and the Umatilla River. The southern boundary is the Morrow County Line, Butter Creek Junction, North Fork Butter Creek Road, and Slucher Canyon Road.

### *Morrow County*

- **Sector R** – an area in Morrow County that runs from Bombing Range Road east to the Umatilla County line. The northern border is Homestead Road. The southern border is Highway 207 and Doherty Klinger Road.
- **Sector S** – includes the Boardman Bombing Range and the P.G.E. coal-fired plant and an area west of the bombing range to Six Mile Canyon.
- **Sector T** – includes the **City of Boardman** and an area that runs from Tower Road east to Bombing Range Road. The northern boundary is the Columbia River. The southern boundary is the northern border of the Boardman Bombing Range.

## WASHINTON SECTORS

### *Benton County*

- **Sector U** includes the area between Klickitat County on the west to Highway 221 on the east, and from Sellards Road on the north to the Columbia River on the south.
- **Sector V** is bounded by Highway 14 on the south, Sellards Road on the north, Highway 221 on the west and Plymouth Road on the east.
- **Sector W** is the area from the Columbia River on the south to Locust Grove, Bateman, Owens and Kirk roads on the north. On the west side the boundary is Plymouth Road. On the east side, the boundary is Finley Road.
