

American Red Cross Shelters

In case of evacuation, the American Red Cross will provide evacuee support for mass care needs in communities outside of the affected area.

Evacuee's can receive Red Cross assistance and information by reporting to one of the following Assistance Centers:

What should I bring with me? - As a minimum, and if time permits, bring:

Prescription Medications
A change of clothing
Special items for infants and disabled family members

Can I bring pets to a shelter? - No. Animals are not allowed in Red Cross shelter with the exception of Service Animals. The Red Cross can direct you to one of many local humane societies or groups that have established disaster plans for the care of animals.

? How do I find out if family members are in a shelter? – Contact the American Red Cross and they will attempt to locate and reunify families.

Listen to a local radio station for more information.

Give the caller the American Red Cross telephone number if you have it, if not...tell them to stay tuned to their radio. We will broadcast it as soon as we receive it. The number will be a toll-free call from anywhere in the U.S.
